Purpose: The Conservation Commission provides these grants to Conservation Districts for activities that will result in long-term environmental benefits. This program is governed by the Grants Administrative Procedure Manual, July 2007 and any legislative budget appropriation notes. This program will work to:

- Prevent or mitigate pollution of the state's water (surface & ground);
- Control sources of water pollution;
- Restore water quality;
- Maintain water quality.

Actual Budget Appropriation Language: "Funding is provided for grants to conservation districts to provide outreach and education services, private landowner outreach and education; develop farm plans, technical and financial assistance to implement farm plans; and manage watershed restoration projects. These activities will help improve water quality, water quantity, and stream bank stabilization."
