- 2. Attach a copy of the district Balance Sheet for the prior fiscal year showing the balance between assets and liabilities. This report is used as a tool to show fiscal responsibility for state match funds.
- 3. Complete the Summary Report (Part II), highlighting how the state funds were spent, used, or leveraged by the district in the prior fiscal year. This Summary should consist of one to three short paragraphs.
- 4. Present the form to the district board for review and certification.
- 5. Any board supervisor may sign and certify the Certification form (Part III).
- 6. Submit Financial Report Form, which includes the Summary Report (Part II) and Certification (Part III) along with a copy of the district Profit & Loss statement and Balance Sheet to the Idaho Soil & Water Conservation Commission on or before November 1st.

CONFIRMATION:

The Commission shall provide written notice, typically via email, to the district within ten (10) days of receipt as to whether the required documents are complete. Once all of the required documents (Antidegradation Plan, Financial Report, and Performance Report) are determined to be complete, the Commission will immediately distribute the Base Funding Allocation to the district.
