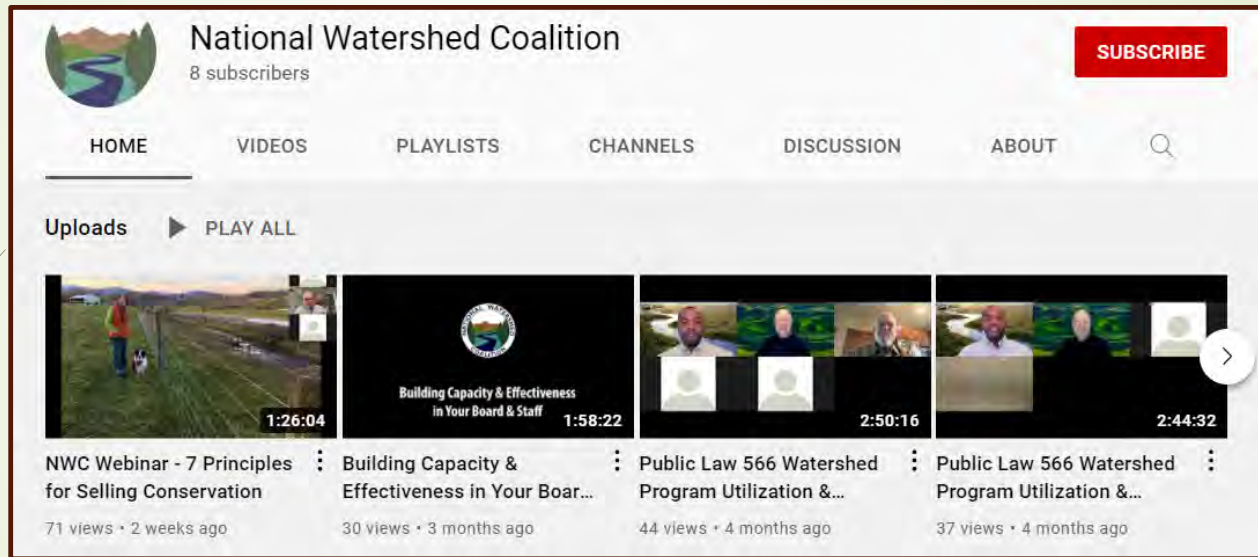

Funding Outlook

- ❖ Permanent funding base (2018 Farm Bill) - \$50M annually
- ❖ Uptick in regular appropriations process
- ❖ \$190M pending current Appropriations Bill
- ❖ 3-yr total approaching \$1B
- ❖ \$918M currently in bipartisan Infrastructure Bill
 - \$500M Ops, \$118M Rehab, \$300M EWP
- ❖ President's Budget

Continuing Resolution

- ◇ As of 9/22/21
 - ◇ Funding through December
 - ◇ \$28.6B Disaster aid (\$10B agriculture)
 - ◇ \$275M NRCS EWP

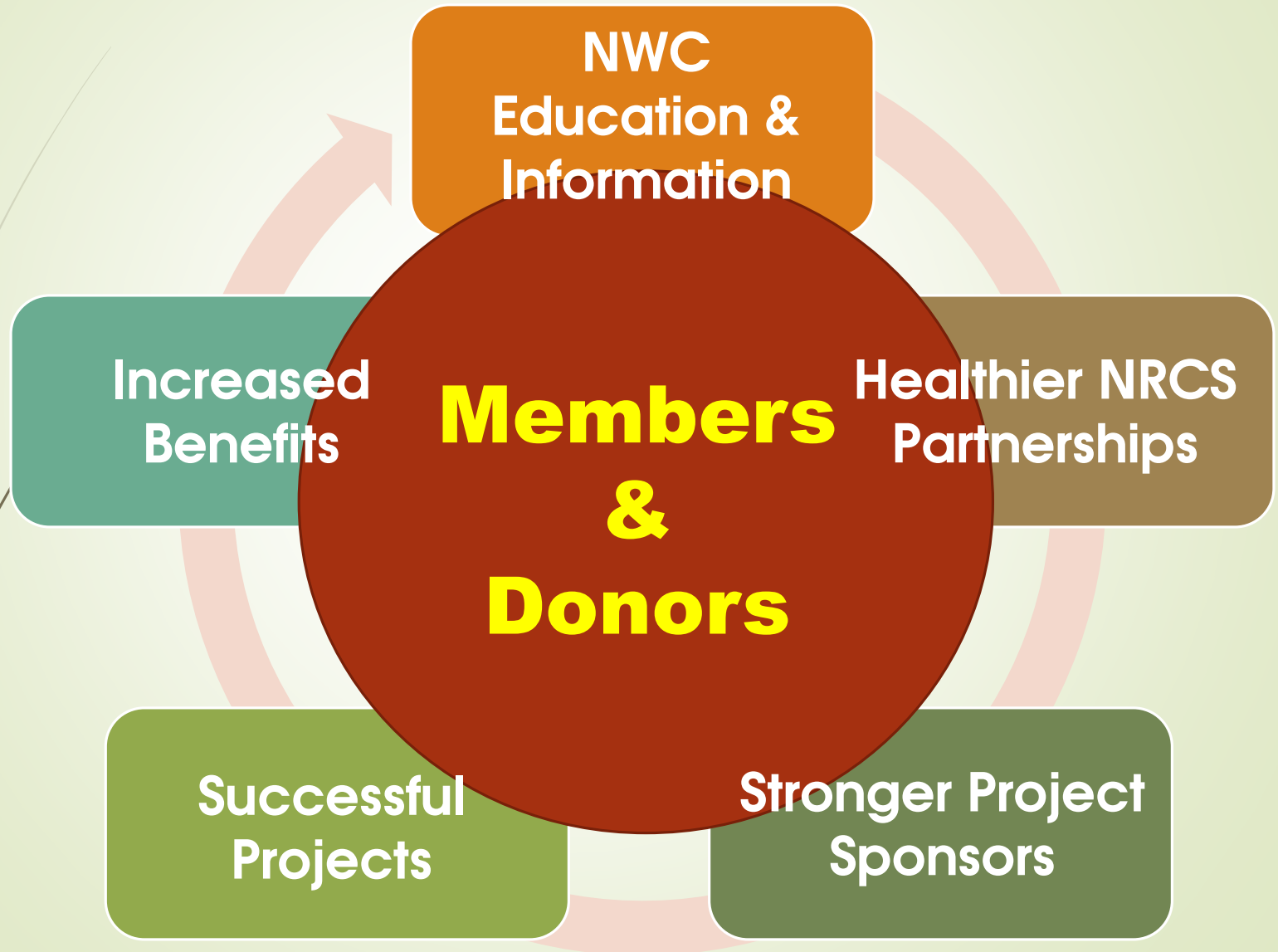
