Michigan's 79 Conservation Districts

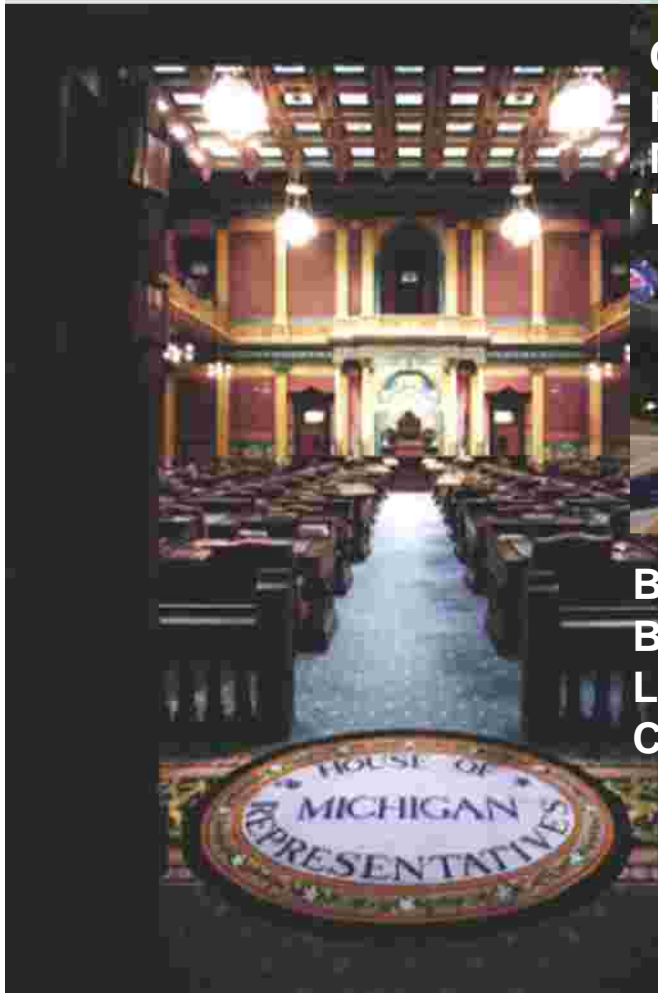

# MACD represents Districts at both the State and National Level

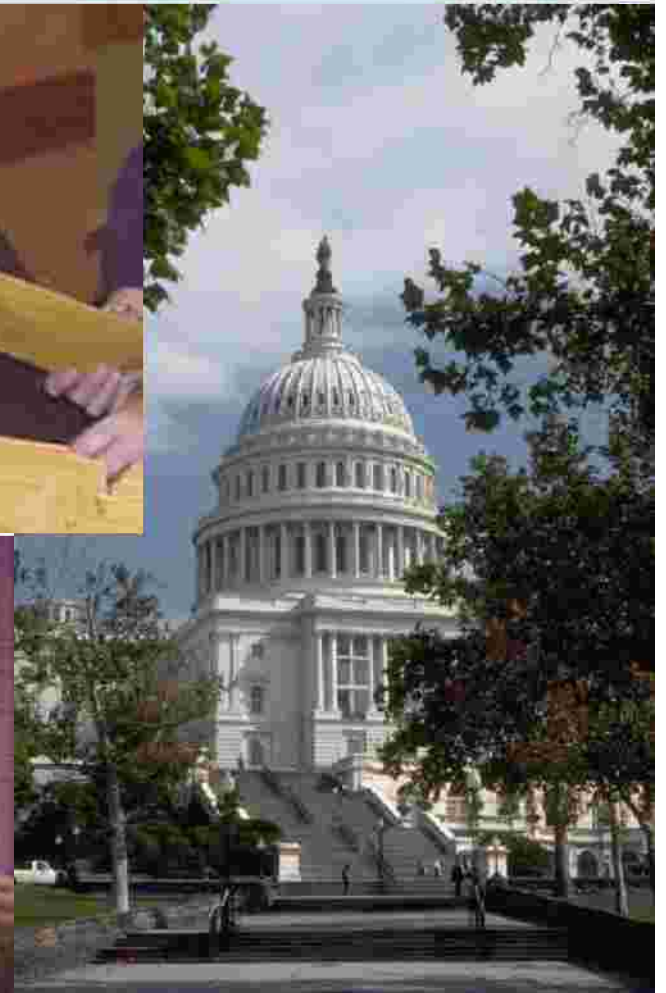
